

# Let's get started with the OneTouch Reveal® web app

Manage Clinic



This web app guide provides instructions for use for each of the tabs and how to use the Settings link to set your preferences.




## Patients Overview Page









# Add a Clinic User or Clinic Manager



Only Clinic Managers can add new Clinic Users:

- 1. Click on Clinic Users tab
- 2. Click on Add User

#### New Page will open:

- 1. Add General Information for user
- 2. Add Contact Information for user
- 3. Add Username and Password for user
- 4. Check box under **User Role** if new user is a Clinic Manager
- 5. Click **Save**



**Clinic Users** individual settings override the Clinic Manager's settings:


- 1. Click on **Settings**

### Edit a Patient Profile





Click the patient's name to edit their profile

Click on **Devices** to see list and edit (to the right of each device) to change the name of a patient's device. Click save when finished.

**Edit:** Click any of the **Edit** hyperlinks to change the information (General Info, Contact Info, Language, Etc.)

Click **Remove** to delete a patient profile
